

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Green Climate Fund (GCF)





• Global Fund created to support efforts of developing countries to respond to challenges of climate change.

- Support developing countries to:
 - Limit of reduce green house gas emissions
 - Adapt to climate change
- Promote paradigm shift to low emission & climate resilient development



Access is not easy

requires processes to be established in country





1. National Designated Authority (NDA) ownership

- Requires processes to ensure that activities align with national strategic priorities
- 2. Accreditation of entities to access resources from the fund
 - Standards are strict (fiduciary & environmental)

3. Project development is extremely complex

• Requires technical know-how in developing greatly justifiable & substantiated projects





GCF support for enhanced access

GCF provides funding to developing country Governments to:





• Strengthening country capacity,

- Engaging stakeholders in consultative processes
- Direct access
- Mobilizing the private sector

Readiness Support

1,000,000 USD / year / country





GCF Readiness Program

In 2016, the Ministry of Climate Change requested Readiness Support from the Green Climate Fund to support:

- 1. the strengthening of the National Designated Authority of the GCF and
- 2. the development a strategic engagement framework with the fund, called a **Country Program**.

Implementation began in 2017

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





National Advisory Board on CCDRR

- Mandated by COM & legislated to oversee all works pertaining to Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction in Vanuatu.
- Oversees and appraises all Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction projects in Vanuatu:
 - all CCDRR projects are reviewed and approved by the NAB before they can be implemented.
 - NAB has a special working group that appraises projects: Project Screening Committee







Submission Process



on Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction

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Once completed, submit the NAB Project Brief Form to the NAB Secretariat.

Who do I submit this to?

NAB Secretariat: <u>nab@meteo.gov.vu</u>

When do I submit this to the NAB Secretariat ?

• when an Accredited Entity has agreed to support the project.

Who should submit the form?

• The AE and be supported by local counterpart.

How many submissions are expected?

• 2 = 1 Concept & 1 full proposal

Screening Process



- 1. Project Screening Committee assesses the project
- 2. Considering the recommendations made by the Project Screening Committee the *NAB makes a decision*.
- 3. The NAB's decision is forwarded to the party seeking endorsement:
 - If the **project concept** is successful, the NAB Secretariat informs the stakeholder and the NDA prepares a validation letter.
 - If the **project concept** is unsuccessful and is conditional, the NAB Secretariat informs the party.
- 4. Full project proposal <u>must be submitted back to the NAB for final review and</u> <u>approval</u>

Timeframe – submission & feedback from NAB

How long does Vanuatu NAB Decision take?

- •~1-2 months
- Vanuatu NAB convenes 6 times/yr
- NAB Project Screening Committee sits prior to Board meetings


